## The Cross of Rebellion

of the man who died in his sins

- An Insulting Heart "He blasphemed Him."
- A Doubting Heart— Saying, "If You are the Christ, save yourself and us."
- **A Rejecting Heart**—A sinner who wants a Savior without a cross.

## The Cross of Repentance

of the man who died <u>to</u> sin

- A Fearing Heart He rebuked him, saying , "Do you not even fear God, seeing you are under the same condemnation?"
- An Accepting Heart "We indeed justly, for we receive the due reward of our deeds; but this Man has done nothing wrong."
- A Believing Heart Then he said to Jesus, "Lord , remember me when You come into your kingdom."

## The Cross of Redemption

of the man who died<u>for</u> sin

- An Asserting Heart And Jesus said to him, "Assuredly, I say to you,"
- A Forgiving Heart " today you will be with Me in Paradise ."
- A Yielding Heart— And when Jesus had cried out with a loud voice, He said, , "Father, into thy hands I commit My spirit." Having said that He breathed His last.
